Crime

On Tuesday, March 1, 2005, at about 2 p.m., the suspect depicted in the composite entered the snack shop of the Mobil station at the Layhill Shopping Center, 2115 Bel Pre Rd, and announced a robbery.

Employees Syed Rizvi and Mr. Z did what they were told, and gave the suspect the money that he demanded.

With no provocation, the suspect then shot Syed Rizvi, 55 years old, in the head in front of other employees and customers. The suspect then fled.

Mr. Rizvi was flown to Maryland Shock Trauma Center, where he was pronounced dead at 3:25 p.m.

"The victim did everything he was asked of him by the suspect," said Officer Derek Bailles, a Montgomery County police spokesman, adding that Rizvi had been "executed." "In front of all those people, he did that."

Black Male (medium complexion)
20 - 30 years of age,
